**ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS RECEIVED**

**Question:** Please provide clarification on how the Maryland PSC intends to handle the Eligibility Documents (i.e. the Binding Offer Agreement, nda, AND Agreement) wherein the Counterparty/Buyer are currently identified as the “EDC” and not specifically the utility that will potentially be contracting under this RFP (BGE, DP&L, PE, and Pepco)?

**Answer:** Eligibility Documents received from bidders will be maintained at the Commission. In the event that a bidder’s bid is not selected, the Eligibility Documents will be marked “Cancelled” and a copy so marked will be returned to the bidder. In the event that a bidder’s bid is awarded, the Eligibility Documents will be submitted to the EDC(s) the Commission directs to enter into the Contract for Differences for execution at the time of execution of the Contract.
