ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS RECEIVED

Question: Per Section 6.5.4 of the RFP

How will the Commission determine the predicted capacity factor for each proposal?

Answer: The capacity factor used to calculate the levelized net present value of a bid will be developed by evaluators for each generation type based on industry data.

Question: I have had the PSC Confidentiality Agreement/NDA document reviewed by our legal department and they have suggested several edits that we would like to see incorporated before we sign the document. We would feel more comfortable signing this agreement knowing that these changes were being made.

Would the PSC consider updating the document to include these changes?

Answer: The PSC will not be making changes to the Confidentiality Agreement (“CA”). You may make changes to the CA but if it alters major terms, CA’s which conform will receive preference and altering major terms may result in not being eligible.
