Final order target date - January 22, 2016¹


¹ The parties requested a 14-day appeal period be specified in the Proposed Order.

Once the specific location and commencement time for the above-scheduled hearings are determined, the Applicant will be directed to notice the hearings as required by Public Utilities Article ("PUA") § 7-207(d)(3). In the event the parties do not reach a settlement, the procedural schedule will be amended accordingly.

Additionally, the Applicant's request for a waiver of the requirement in PUA § 7-208(c)(1) to file at least two years before construction of the facility will commence was granted for good cause.
