1    **Q.     PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME, BUSINESS ADDRESS AND TITLE.**

2    A.     My name is Edwin C. Moses. My title is Vice President, Project Development, at Origis  
3         Energy. My business address is 800 Brickell Avenue, Suite 1100, Miami, Florida 33131.

4    **Q.     PLEASE DESCRIBE YOUR QUALIFICATIONS.**

5    A.     I have more than two decades of solar, storage and energy system development, having  
6         worked in project development finance throughout the US as well as selective  
7         international markets. At Origis Energy, I manage the company's project development  
8         team and am responsible for bringing projects from inception to successful completion of  
9         project permitting and then assist during the project construction and operation phases.

10        Prior to joining Origis Energy, I served as an Executive Director at NextEra Energy  
11        Resources, a leading US renewable energy development firm. My renewables project  
12        finance experience includes roles at Marathon Capital and RBC Capital Markets.

13        I hold a Masters of Business Administration from The University of Texas at Austin and  
14        received a Bachelor of Arts with Honors in Economics, from the University of Maryland.

15   **Q.     HAVE YOU PREVIOUSLY TESTIFIED BEFORE THIS COMMISSION?**

16   A.     No.

17   **Q.     ARE YOU FAMILIAR WITH MD SOLAR 2, LLC'S PROJECT IN CHARLES**  
18         **COUNTY, MARYLAND?**

19   A.     Yes. I have been involved in the development of Ripley Solar Project (the "Project"), the  
20         execution of the Project Power Purchase Agreement, and I have managed or supported its  
21         development in collaboration with a team at Origis Energy and our external consultants.

I am well-acquainted with all aspects of the Project, including site review and assessment, environmental review and approvals, design and layout, local permits, PJM and Southern Maryland Electric Cooperative (“SMECO”) interconnection studies, and overall project scheduling and planning.

**Q. PLEASE PROVIDE SOME BACKGROUND ON MD SOLAR 1, LLC.**

A. MD Solar 2, LLC is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Origis Energy. Origis Energy develops, finances, builds, and operates solar facilities across Europe and the Americas.

**Q. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF YOUR TESTIMONY IN THIS PROCEEDING?**

A. To introduce MD Solar 2, LLC and to sponsor the portions of MD Solar 2, LLC’s Environmental Review Document not sponsored by Dane S. Bauer.<sup>1</sup>
