Re: CP Crane, LLC (PSC Case No. 9482) Administrative Completeness Review

Dear Judge Lawrence:

CP Crane LLC (CP Crane) submitted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) application with the Maryland Public Service Commission (PSC) on May 31, 2018. Crane provided a supplement to the application on June 21, 2018. The purpose of the application is to seek approval for a modification of the existing CP Crane electric generating station located in Baltimore County, MD. Based on a preliminary review of the CPCN application and supplemental material, the Power Plant Research Program (PPRP) of the Maryland Department of Natural Resources (DNR) and the Air and Radiation Administration (ARA) of the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) informed Crane on July 10, 2018 that the application was administratively incomplete as it did not contain information required for compliance with the federal Clean Air Act (CAA).

In response to the deficiencies cited, CP Crane submitted an amended CPCN application to the PSC on August 31, 2018. PPRP and ARA have reviewed the amended application and determined that the application now contains all of the information required by the CAA to proceed with the technical review and has therefore deemed the application to be administratively complete. As the State agencies proceed with the technical review of the application, CP Crane may be required to provide additional data as necessary for the State agencies to complete the review and prepare appropriate recommendations and licensing conditions for the facility. Prompt and complete responses to such data requests are expected in order to facilitate a timely review of the application and adherence to a procedural schedule.
